Quality Assurance

A Manufacturer can import from a facility that states they manufacture the eyewear to the latest ANSI standard

OR

A Manufacturer can

- Design the tooling,
- Employ a team of 40+ QC engineers to perform rigorous QC inspections at the location where the eyewear is being manufacture
- AND ALSO submit all product for 3rd party independent testing to the latest ANSI standard.

Quality Assurance

Our goal is not to meet expectations and standards.....
We **EXCEED** them!!

In 2010 the New ANSI Z78.1 standard kept the impact requirement, but removed the lens thickness requirement. Some manufactures took advantage of this regulation change as an opportunity to produce a thinner lens that still met the impact requirement.

All ProGuard Protective Eyewear is manufactured with a minimum 2mm lens thickness as required by the ANSI Z78.1-2003 prior standard.

What does this mean? Our lens not only meet the ANSI Z78.1 -2010 standards they exceed them. The thicker lenses are more durable and offer additional UV protection.
